

How to Access a Video Visit Through Your Computer

Please follow these steps to start your scheduled video visit with your provider from your computer.

Video visits are only done through a One Chart | Patient account.

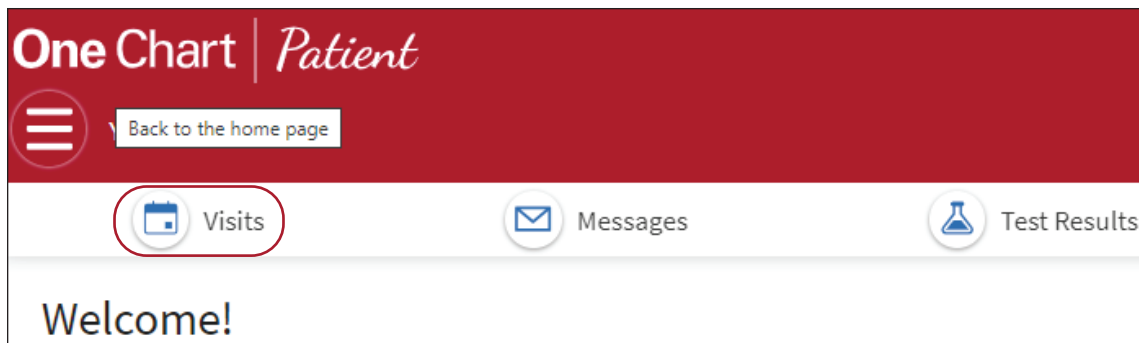
If you don't have one, you can make an account by going to **NebraskaMed.com/OneChart** before proceeding with these instructions.

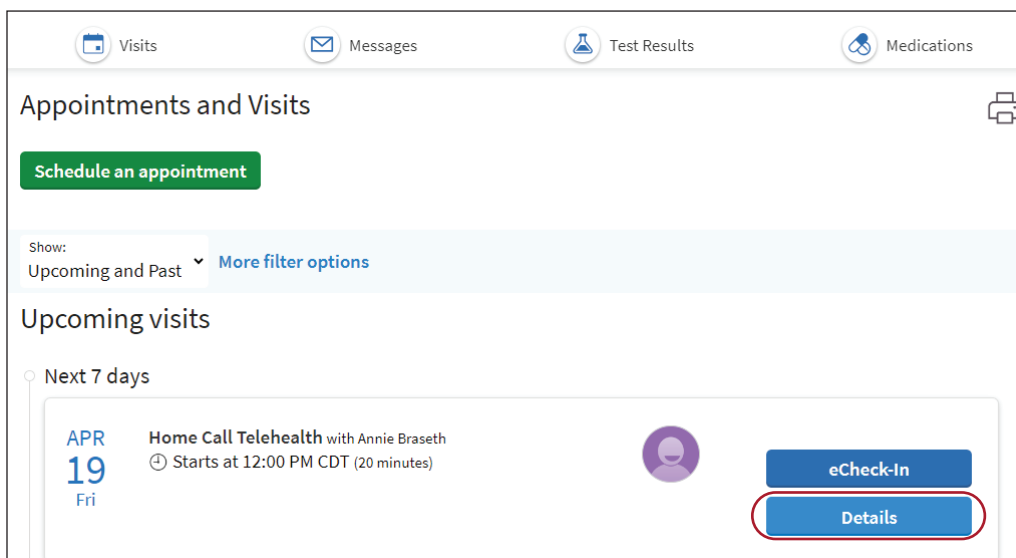
Instructions include the following:

Step 1: On your home computer, visit **www.onechartpatient.com** and log in to your account.

Step 2: Select the **Visits** button at the top of the screen.



Step 3: Under **Upcoming Visits**, find the **Home Call Telehealth** visit. Click on the blue **Details** button to the right of the visit information.



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Step 4: Click the **Join video visit** button to let the provider know you are ready.

Step 5: Wait for your provider to join.

You may be asked to allow access to your camera and microphone. Please select **Continue**, then **Allow**.
