What is an eConsult?

A primary care physician may have a question about your care that is best answered by a doctor with special training (specialist). An eConsult allows your primary care doctor to ask a specialist a question, using our electronic medical record, on your behalf to work together to make a plan.

Why use eConsults?

eConsults are an easy and useful way for a Nebraska Medicine specialist to review your health care issue and give recommendations for care. By reviewing your health care chart, a specialist can oftentimes make a diagnosis and form a plan of care for you without you ever needing to come to the office for an in person visit. The technology is safe with strict patient privacy standards used for the doctor eConsult.

How will you get your results?

Your primary care provider will follow up with you about the result of your eConsult and will let you know the specialist's recommendation for your care.

What is the cost?

An eConsult is another health care visit and, as such, there may be a fee for the eConsult. Most major insurers cover the cost of eConsults. For those not covered by insurance there will be a \$115 fee to cover the expense of the specialist to review your records and give feedback on your health care issue.

Will I still need to see a specialist in person?

Many health care issues are able to be handled by the eConsult tool. There may be times in which a specialist needs to see you in person. If this is the case, your eConsult fee will be waived and a priority visit will be scheduled for you with the specialist.
