

Get the Best Value for Your Prescriptions

It's the pharmacy's goal that all Nebraska Medicine patients, including colleagues and their families, receive the medications they need at the best price possible. Below are some tips ensure you're getting the best value for your prescriptions.

1. Use Nebraska Medicine Pharmacy locations

Unlike other retail pharmacies which make a profit on prescriptions, the Nebraska Medicine Pharmacy only charges colleagues the cost of the prescription, with no additional markup.

2. Use Nebraska Medicine clinics that qualify for discounted pricing

The Nebraska Medicine Pharmacy can purchase medications at a discounted price for care that is received at a qualifying Nebraska Medicine location (see reverse page for full list) or for patients who are discharged from Nebraska Medical Center.

When colleagues receive services at one of these qualified locations, the pharmacy can purchase the medications prescribed at a discounted price and then pass the savings on to the colleague.

3. Create a referral relationship

If your prescriptions come from a provider at a location that does not qualify for discounted pricing, you may qualify for a referral relationship between a Nebraska Medicine provider at a qualified location and the provider at a non-qualified location. This includes specialty providers for which Nebraska Medicine does not offer service.

Contact our medication access coordinator (details above) to assist you with the referral process, which is valid for one year and can be renewed each year.

4. Take advantage of available resources, including pharmaceutical company rebates and coupons or finding a more cost effective medication options

The Nebraska Medicine Pharmacy can connect you with resources available to help with costs. Medication access coordinators (details above) can review your medications, find additional copay assistance or work with pharmacists and your provider to find more cost effective alternative therapies.

5. Fill a 90-day supply for the price of a 60-day supply

A 90-day supply of medication can be filled for the price of a 60-day supply only at Nebraska Medicine Pharmacy locations. As a convenience, the Nebraska Medicine Pharmacy will also ship medications for free to you and your family members.
